**Turkish Cargo expands the network with SPA's in offline destinations**

Already providing cargo services to 190 online destinations in 82 countries, TURKISH CARGO aims to serve its customers at offline destinations as well. TURKISH CARGO negotiated worldwide SPA's with partner Airlines, which are dominant in their region just to develop its own network.

**TURKISH CARGO November Statistics**

After the record growth has been made during 2010, in 2011 growing trend is continuing. Cargo-Postal shipments January-November 2010 period was 283.220 tonnes. Whereas, in 2011 same period it is increased to 351.504 tonnes which is more than 24,11% higher than previous year. Cargo shipments on November 2010 was 25.744 tons. However, in November 2011 there is a 35,13% increase to 34.788 tonnes.

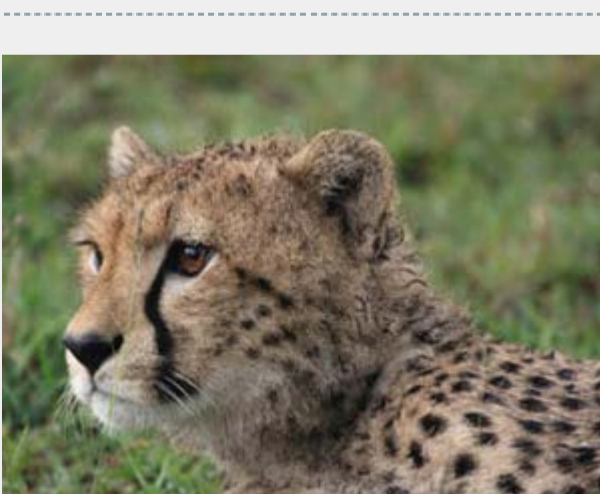
**Wild Cats on Board**

To being carried from the South African city Johannesburg to the capital of Bulgaria, Sofia, the Serval Cat transported to Istanbul after 7,5 hours flight by Turkish Airlines A330 passenger aircraft.

Only 1.5 hours after arriving in Istanbul, Serval Cat (Leptailurus serval), even nicked as "giraffe cat", its cage has been comforted in the belly hold of the plane to continue to Sofia.
